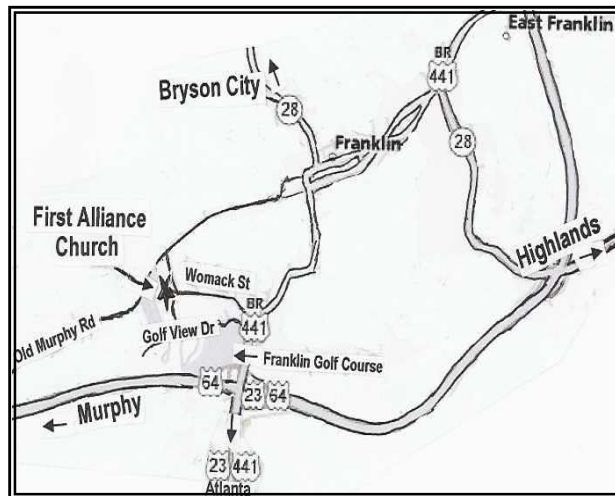

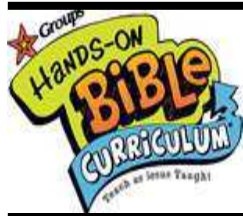

Classes for Kids Located in The Basement

3 and 4 year olds

3 & 4 Year Olds will begin the quarter looking at creation. In module 2 they will look at the life of Noah and learn that God cares for us and helps us even in scary times and that He keeps His promises. They will end the quarter by looking at Abraham and Sarah to learn that God loves us and helps us follow Him, gives us what we need, calls us by name and gives us good surprises

Pre K & Kindergarten

Will also begin the quarter by looking at creation. They will focus on the Bible points that God made our world and made us special. Module 2 will look at the life of Noah to focus on the fact that God is in charge, through these lessons they will learn that He is sad when we do wrong, that he watches over us and that He keeps His promises. Module 3 will focus on trusting God with lessons from the life of Abraham.

1st and 2nd Grade

Will begin the quarter looking at creation. Module 2 will focus on 3 leaders of the faith, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. Through these 3 they will learn that we can trust God, sometimes God says wait and that He wants us to get along with others and forgive. Module 3 will focus on prayer practicing communicating with God in many fun and creative ways. They will understand that God hears our prayers all the time.

3rd and 4th Grade

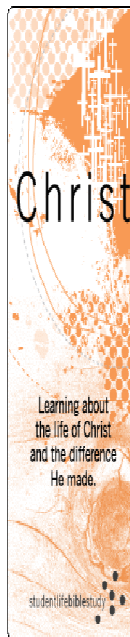
Will begin the quarter focusing on creation, learning that we are made in God's image, He gives us choices, helps us handle our angry feelings and calls us to take care of our world. Module 2 will take them on adventures with Abraham, seeing that God is in control of our future. Module 3 will help our children understand the Bible. They will develop skills in using the Bible, learn about the Bible's message and realize that the Bible can help answer their difficult questions.
